First College Examination for Diplomate Membership

The Examination was divided into 2 parts:

- (A) Written/Theory Examination
- (B) Clinical Examination

The written/theory examination was held on the 5th November, 1972, Sunday, at the Postgraduate Medical School commencing at 10.00 a.m. and the clinicals on the 12th November, 1972, Sunday, at the Outram Road General Hospital O.P.D. - Medical Unit III, at 8.30 a.m.

In the written examination the candidates were required to sit for 3 papers:

- (1) Essay Questions (2 hours)
- (2) 1st Multiple Choice Questions (1 hour)
- (3) 2nd Multiple Choice Questions (1 hour)

In the clinical examination the candidates were examined in 4 sections:

- (1) Long Case
- (2) Short Case
- (3) Practical - E.C.G.s, X'rays etc.
- (4) Viva

The viva serve as an opportunity to fill in areas which may not have been covered or were obviously poorly done and to further probe and assess professed abilities.

In the whole examination, the candidates were assessed under:

- (1) Knowledge
- (2) Interpretive ability
- (3) Problem solving ability
- (4) Psychomotor skills
- (5) Attitudes as a family physician

To assist us in our first College Examination, in addition to our College examiners, we enlisted the help of our sister College and medical colleagues.

The standard attained was acceptable by all the examiners and officially the R.A.C.G.P. examiners said that the candidates who have passed the first College Examination would have passed the M.R.A.C.G.P. Examination.

A meeting was called of all candidates and examiners at the Alumni Medical Centre on 9th December, 1972, to generally discuss the views and comments of the examiners and the problems of the candidates in the Examination. Certain candidates felt that the examination was deficient in certain areas e.g. public health and community health; that the wordings of a few of the M.C.Qs. could be improved and that there was some misunderstanding in the expectation of the candidates regarding the examination. Queries were made on the marking of the M.C.Q. 2 paper.

The Examination itself provides an educational experience by moving the candidates to undertake specific studies to develop his skills in family medicine, by providing him with an assessment of his performance after the examination is over and by stimulating him to maintain his interests in continuing education.

## Examination Evaluation Seminar

An invitation was extended by the Royal Australian College of General Practitioners to our College to attend the Examination Evaluation Seminar which was held in Bruce Hall, Australian National University, Canberra, A.C.T. from 17th - 25th February, 1973. This Seminar was a live-in Seminar of the top men of the College who have been closely associated with the R.A.C.G.P. Diploma Examination over the years. The last Seminar took place in 1967.

The aim of the Seminar was to review the whole status and purpose of the Examination, to evaluate its performance to date and to assess whether it is achieving the original objectives expected of it.

Two representatives from our College attended the Seminar. They were Drs. Foo Choong Khean and Wong Kum Hoong. The setting of questions (e.g. M.C.Q. and Essay), as a whole and other issues like diagnostic and management interviews and practical examination were discussed. On the whole, our representatives learned a lot from the Australian College and gained a greater understanding of the examination system as a whole.

Our College will be holding the next Diplomate Membership Examination this year on the following days:

## R E S E A R C H

Modest research was initiated during the year. In co-operation with the staff of the Department of Bacteriology, six general practitioners participated in two studies aimed at defining the common agents responsible for pyogenic skin infections and upper respiratory infections. It is hoped to correlate clinical data with the final bacterial and viral culture results, thereby throwing some light on the vexing problem of the need for and choice of antibiotics in these common clinical situations.

The College has acquired an incubator at a cost of \$1,990 for research purposes.

One essentially "clinical" study on the clinical aspects and morbidity of measles is being implemented.

Other possible subjects for G.P. research are being considered.

(3) First Annual Report of the Council

(6) To Appoint Auditor

(b) Dr. Frederick Samuel congratulated the Education Committee for the work they have done so far and he expressed his views that the College Examination should be a searching one especially in the art of practice and what the doctor has learned in the course of general practice.

(c) Dr. Lim Chan Yong suggested that the Finance Committee should look into donations by members for the College Fund. He suggested that members should donate a day's collection towards the College Fund.

(d) Dr. Colin Marcus suggested that the pledged donation by members to the College should be stretched over a period of time.

There being no other business, the meeting ended at 4.50 p.m. with a vote of thanks to the chair.
